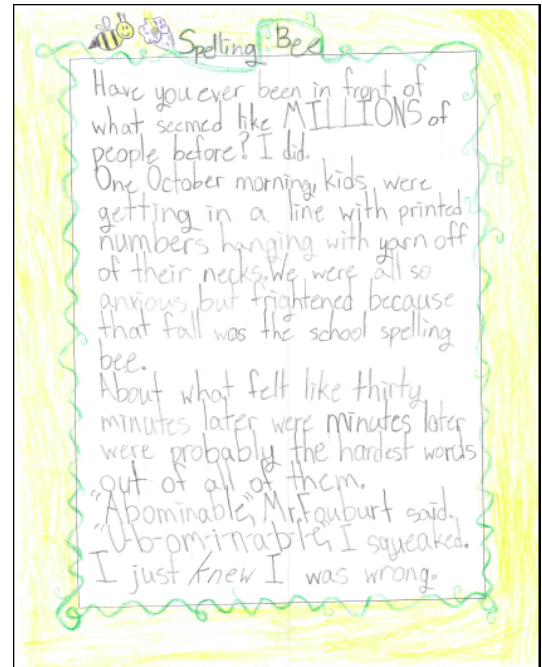


3rd Grade Student Learning Profile

Intermediate students are transitioning from learning how to read to reading to learn. This learning is preparing them to think, read, discuss, and write critically and effectively. In order to do this successfully students need to be able to evaluate and synthesize multiple texts in order to form opinions, make claims, use evidence to support their claim, and finally interpret implications for this new information. Intermediate students are reading, interpreting, discussing, and writing equal amounts of fiction and non-fiction.

Third grade students are learning to interpret information. Third graders can distinguish their own point of view. In both fiction and non-fiction texts, they can interpret multiple texts analyzing text structure, interpreting figurative language, and summarizing by determining central messages and using key details to support their thinking both verbally and in writing. In writing, they produce opinion, narrative, and informative pieces with guidance and support from adults. They can also conduct short research projects to build knowledge about a topic for themselves and others.
