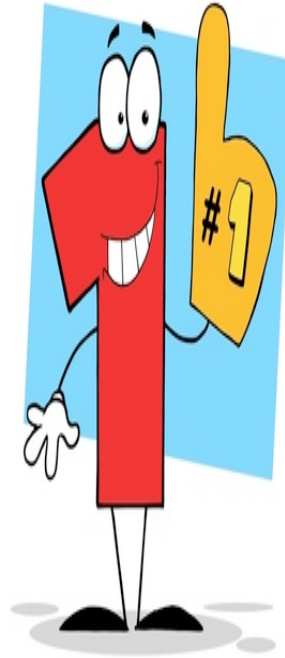


Kindergarten Math

Number Sense

- Counts to 50 and beyond
- Counts backwards from 22
- Accurately counts a set of objects by touch
- Identifies and writes numbers 0-30 and other 2 digit numbers
- Can put number cards in order from 0-10
- Counts by 10's
- Places objects in groups of 2 and groups of 3
- Identifies penny, nickel, dime and quarter and understands values of coins



Geometry

- Identifies a circle, rectangle, square and triangle
- Understands positional words such as first, middle, last
- Understands spatial reasoning using vocabulary such as on top, under, beside, inside

Statistics and Probability

- Analyzes a bar graph and can answer the questions:

Which is the least?
Which is the most?
How Many?
How many More?

Algebra

- Understands concept of sorting and resorting objects based on similarities and differences
- Uses correct vocabulary to describe sizes of objects
- Orders objects from smallest to largest
- Creates and expands patterns

Computation

- Adds and subtracts small numbers
- Uses +, -, and = symbols in a number sentence

Measurement

- Accurately measures length of objects using nonstandard tools
